



**CRITERIA FOR THE PROVINCIAL LITNUM SCHOOL AWARDS BASED ON MERITORIOUS ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE BY SCHOOLS IN GRADES 3, 6 AND 9.**

**CATEGORIES OF AWARDS**

In terms of the 2012 Grades 3, 6 and 9 Language and Mathematics results, awards to schools are allocated in the following categories:

**CATEGORY 1: EXCELLENCE IN OUTCOMES**

**Category 1 (a)**

**Overall Excellence in Outcomes: Grades 3 and 6**

In this category, awards are made to the top ten (10) public ordinary schools with an enrolment of 30 learners or more and where the combined performance at Grade 3 and Grade 6 level in Language and Mathematics in 2012 illustrates meritorious outcomes. Excellence of outcomes is measured in terms of the average of the mean scores in both Language and Mathematics.

Schools with an enrolment of between 20 and 30 learners and who meet the above criteria will also be considered for a special award.

All awardees will receive a certificate as well as a **monetary incentive** of R15 000, 00 for the purchase of teaching and learning support material.

Excellence of outcomes is measured in terms of the average of the mean scores in both Language and Mathematics providing the school has achieved a pass rate of 90% or more at Grade 9 level in 2012.

All awardees will receive a certificate as well as a **monetary incentive** of R15 000, 00 for the purchase of teaching and learning support material.
