Hugo Theart: receives the Ministerial Commendation in recognition of his outstanding contribution to Music and the Arts.

Currently serving as the Artistic Director of the Klein Karoo Nasionale Kunste fees (KKNK), Hugo Theart has made a significant contribution to the world of music and arts. Theart's presence is felt throughout the festival as he actively engages attendees. He has not only shaped the festival, but he has significantly contributed to the South African cultural landscape through his exceptional leadership and commitment to music and the arts. Through his passion and dedication, the KKNK continues to inspire those who encounter it, illustrating how art can drive positive change and shape a better world. His leadership has guided the KKNK to embark on a new journey, cementing its position as a South African cultural beacon.

Phillip Mthobeli Guma: receives the Ministerial Commendation in recognition of his commitment to the preservation of customary traditions and for his contribution to the Western Cape Initiation Framework and Protocol.

Dr Phillip Mthobeli Guma is a remarkable individual whose unwavering commitment to preserving customary traditions has left an indelible mark on South African society. As an academic and a practicing indigenous healer, he embodies a unique blend of academic rigour and deep cultural immersion. Driven by his passion for the promotion of biodiversity and cultural practices as integral components of social cohesion and nation-building, Guma has emerged as a beacon of hope for safeguarding the rich tapestry of South Africa's heritage. His role as a Medical Anthropologist underscores his holistic approach to the preservation of these traditions, transcending the boundaries of both academia and tradition. His pivotal contribution to the Western Cape Initiation Framework and Protocol stands as a testament to his dedication to ensuring that these age-old customs continue to thrive, fostering a sense of identity and unity among the people of South Africa. Guma's tireless efforts resonate as a source of inspiration for all who value the importance of preserving and celebrating our cultural roots.

Crispin Sonn: receives the Ministerial Commendation in recognition of his outstanding contribution to Music and the Arts.

Crispin Sonn serves as the chairperson of the Klein Karoo National Arts Festival (KKNK) board. Under his leadership, the KKNK has grown into a cherished family festival that draws visitors not only from all corners of

South Africa but also from around the world. Through the annual festival and various other projects, Sonn and the KKNK team are committed to making a positive and constructive contribution to nation-building. They do so by being a trusted and sincere participant in the arts community, fostering sustainable platforms, promoting innovation, nurturing networks and actively contributing to economic and social development. Sonn's leadership and dedication exemplify how the arts can play a pivotal role in bringing people together, fostering cultural understanding and building a brighter future for all.

Daniel Hugo: receives the Ministerial Commendation in recognition of his outstanding contribution to Literature (poetry) and translation of many books from Afrikaans to English and/or Dutch or vice versa.

Dr Daniel Hugo is a distinguished poet, translator, compiler and editor who has made an indelible mark on the world of literature. His multifaceted career has been a testament to his unwavering commitment to the written word. Throughout his career, Hugo served as a specialist announcer and producer for Radio Sonder Grense, the national Afrikaans radio service. He played a pivotal role in curating and presenting literary programmes such as *Leeskring* and *Vers en Klank*. As a prolific poet, Hugo has authored several poetry albums. His poetry resonates with readers, touching on various facets of life and human experience. Furthermore, Hugo's contribution to literature extends beyond his own creations. He has earned recognition as a skilled translator, bridging the gap between languages and cultures. His translations from Dutch to Afrikaans encompass works by acclaimed authors such as Tom Lanoye, Herman de Coninck, Harry Mulisch, Herman van Veen, Karel Glastra van Loon, and David van Reybrouck. Through his translations, he has enriched the literary landscape and made significant Dutch literary works accessible to Afrikaans-speaking readers.

ATKV: receives the Ministerial Commendation for promoting choir development through their Applous Programme (40 years) and songwriting programme, Crescendo (50 years).

The ATKV (Afrikaans Language and Culture Association) and its Applous Programme are pillars of Afrikaans culture and heritage in South Africa. Founded in 1930, the ATKV has evolved into a dynamic organisation with a mission to promote and preserve the Afrikaans language, culture and creativity. The Applous programme, in particular, stands out as the country's oldest school choir competition, providing a platform for students to express their love for Afrikaans through choral music. It brings together primary and high school choirs, fostering a sense of community and pride in the rich linguistic and cultural tapestry of South Africa. Through these initiatives, the ATKV continues to play a crucial role in enriching the nation's cultural fabric and promoting the values of inclusivity and diversity.

André van der Merwe: receives the Ministerial Commendation in recognition of the Stellenbosch University Choir having been honoured internationally as the best mixed choir in the world for the past 11 years.

André van der Merwe is a renowned choral conductor hailing from Durbanville in Cape Town. With his exceptional leadership and dedication to choral singing, he has left an indelible mark on music. The Stellenbosch University Choir and the Stellenberg Girls Choir have been under Van der Merwe's direction since 2003. Both ensembles have garnered an impressive array of national and international awards under his expert guidance, displaying his exceptional ability to nurture and develop young vocalists. Van der Merwe's many accomplishments include his arrangements of African music that have been published by Earthsongs in the USA, solidifying his influence on the global choral repertoire. Van der Merwe's prowess as a conductor was celebrated on the international stage when he clinched the prestigious title of Best Conductor at the Llangollen International Eisteddfod in Wales in July 2018, further cementing his status as a luminary in the world of choral music. Throughout his career, his dedication to music has transcended borders, taking him to music festivals and competitions in countries as diverse as China, Singapore, Russia, Wales, Italy, Germany, Japan and Indonesia from 2016 to 2018. Van der Merwe's tireless commitment to the art of choral conducting has not only enriched the lives of countless singers but has also elevated South African and international choral music to new heights, leaving an enduring legacy in the hearts and voices of all who have had the privilege of working with him.

Isabella Niehaus: receives the Ministerial Legacy Award in recognition of her outstanding contribution to literature, specifically as an award-winning author of South African cuisine books.

Isabella Niehaus has made an indelible mark on the world of South African cuisine. With accolades that include being recognised as one of the Top Women restaurateurs and a three-time recipient of the prestigious Top 10 Women Chefs in the Cape accolade, Niehaus' culinary journey is nothing short of extraordinary. Her legendary Sunday lunches, held at her picturesque home overlooking the Langebaan Lagoon, have transformed strangers into lifelong friends, embodying the true spirit of hospitality. However, it is her literary contributions that have truly set her apart. Her cookbook, *Duinhuys Smake, Geure*, secured global acclaim by winning the "Best in the World" title at the 2020 Gourmand World Cookbook Awards, a testament to her prowess in showcasing the rich flavours of South African cuisine.

Hazel Jonker: receives the Ministerial Legacy Award in recognition of her outstanding contribution to heritage conservation and promotion in the Klein Karoo and specifically Oudtshoorn.

Hazel Jonker is the esteemed chair of Heritage Oudtshoorn Erfenis. She has played an instrumental role in advancing the cause of heritage conservation and promotion within the Klein Karoo, with a particular focus on the historic town of Oudtshoorn. Her leadership within this organisation, which collaborates closely with De Rust Heritage, has been a driving force behind the strict adherence to the National Heritage Resources Act in areas teeming with invaluable heritage resources, notably De Rust. Jonker's public engagement as a guest speaker at heritage-related events and her active involvement in discussions surrounding heritage inventories and overlay zones in the Greater Oudtshoorn Municipal area, encompassing De Rust, Dysselsdorp, Volmoed and Schoemanshoek, underscores her unwavering commitment to preserving the cultural legacy of this unique region. Jonker's contributions are a testament to her passion for safeguarding the rich history and cultural heritage of Oudtshoorn and its surroundings.

Fatima Dike: receives the Ministerial Legacy Award in recognition of her outstanding contribution to the Arts in the Theatre and drama discipline.

Fatima Dike is a luminary in the world of theatre and drama, celebrated for her remarkable contributions to the arts. Born in Langa, her journey into the world of creativity began while working at her brother-in-law's bookshop in Langa. It was here that her friend Sue Clark introduced her to the enchanting world of poetry, igniting her passion for writing. In 1972, fate led her to the nascent Space Theatre, where she embarked on her theatrical career as an assistant stage manager and, eventually, as a stage manager. She ventured into playwriting and her inaugural work, *The Sacrifice of Kreli*, earned her the prestigious role of resident playwright at the Space. Dike's artistic journey took her from Cape Town to New York and upon her return, she made her indelible mark as a stage manager and actress in numerous productions, including *Die Laaste Middagmaal*, *Fallen Angels* and *Lysistrata SA*. She also penned a series of captivating plays, including *The First South African*, *The Crafty Tortoise* and *Street Walking*, showcasing her diverse talents. Her profound impact on the world of theatre was further exemplified when she co-founded the Siyasanga South African Theatre Company with Roy Sargeant in 2006. Throughout her illustrious career, she continued to inspire and innovate, receiving accolades such as the Lifetime Achievement Award at the Black Theatre Festival in North Carolina in 2009 and the Naledi Lifetime Achievement Award in 2014. Dike's enduring legacy in theatre and drama is a testament to her exceptional talent and unwavering dedication to the arts.

Tete Mbambisa: receives the Ministerial Legacy Award in recognition of his outstanding contribution to music.

Born in Duncan Village, East London on 9 January 1942, Tete Mbambisa is one of the most gifted pianists and composers emerging from the 1950s era. He has kept the original and unique 1950s sound alive and has nurtured many of today's best young jazz talents. With his inventive piano playing, Mbambisa helped to preserve South Africa's acoustic jazz tradition during the genre's decline in the 1970s and 1980s. In addition to performing as a soloist, Mbambisa often accompanies vocalist Ncediwe Sylvia Mdunyelwa.

George Werner: receives the Ministerial Legacy Award in recognition of his contribution to jazz as a pianist.

George Werner is a remarkable pianist who has left an indelible mark on the Cape Town jazz scene. His legacy roars through the Cape Town jazz community, with his profound commitment to nurturing young talents in underprivileged communities. Together with fellow jazz legend Ezra Ngcukana, he established the vibrant jazz group the Little Giants, and dedicated himself to educating budding musicians. Leaving his day job as a Telkom technician more than four decades ago, Werner embarked on a

musical journey that would grace local festivals and international stages alike, including Japan and Brazil. Collaborating with jazz luminaries such as Winston "Mankunku" Ngozi, Sylvia Mdunyelwa and Thandi Klaasen, his music exudes elegance and harmony. His dedication to music education earned him the SA Association for Jazz Education (SAJE) distinguished teacher award in 2012. Under his mentorship, talents like Chris Engel, Sisonke Xonti and Shaun Johannes have flourished. Today, Werner's legacy lives on, not in his stature but in the countless lives he has touched through his enduring commitment to jazz and youth education, all while humbly playing on at venues like The Crypt in Cape Town. Werner is a true giant of music and mentorship, an unsung hero whose impact resonates through generations of musicians.

Alvin Dyers: receives the Ministerial Legacy Award in recognition of his contribution to jazz music as an educator and guitarist.

Jazz guitarist and educator Alvin Dyers was born in Harfield Village (Cape Town) in 1953. He started playing guitar from the age of seven. He formed his first band called Sacred Legion with his equally talented brother, Errol Dyers. He also formed part of the group musicians that played in Pacific Express in the 80s. Some of the musicians he has played with, include other legends, for example Winston "Mankunku" Ngozi, Ezra Ngcukana and Johnny Fourie. He is currently a jazz guitar teacher at the University of Cape Town, where he continues to nurture and inspire another generation of jazz musicians in the province.

Spencer Mbadu: receives the Ministerial Legacy Award (Posthumous) in recognition of his contribution to jazz as a bassist.

Spencer Mbadu was born in January 1955 in 10th Avenue, Mtshoko Block, Kensington. In 1958 his family was forcefully moved to Nyanga West, later named Gugulethu. His influence of music came from home, where his grandmother used to play the harp and piano. From the age of four he tried his hand at several musical instruments such as guitar, voice, drums and piano before he chose the bass in 1972 as his instrument of choice. He never studied music formally, but cites Kader Khan as having introduced him to sight reading. This saw him join bands such as Siyabuya, Skyf, Spirits Rejoice and Fever, where he played music ranging from big band sounds to pop. He played with several notable musicians such as Abdullah Ibrahim, Bheki Mseleku, Sylvia Mdunyelwa, Ntemi Piliso, Tony Cedras, Russell Herman, Ezra Ngcukana and Enoch Mthalane, to name a few.

Zelda Benjamin: receives the Ministerial Legacy Award in recognition of her outstanding contributions to jazz and music as a vocalist.

Vocalist and musician Zelda Benjamin was born in District Six on 21 October 1936. A self-taught jazz vocalist, she started singing around the age of twenty at a club called The Naaz in Lower Main Street, Woodstock with the pianist Cecil May. Since then, she has been a permanent feature on Cape Town music and jazz scene, playing for dances and ballroom competitions. Benjamin also did a recording with Basil Moses, Henry February, Monty Weber (drums) and Charlie Hamilton. In between all the singing, she had to do other jobs, like working for a dry-cleaning company and the Department of Health, but she never stopped her singing career. To this day, Benjamin still performs, and she has appeared at venues such as the Three Cellars, The Balalaika, Zambezi and many more.

Erken uitstaande bydraes in hul onderskeie velde in die Kuns- en Kultuursektor

Hugo Theart: ontvang die Minister se Spesiale Toekenning as erkenning vir sy uitstaande bydrae tot musiek en kuns.

Hugo Theart dien tans as die Kunsregisseur van die Klein Karoo Nasionale Kunstefees. Hy het 'n betekenisvolle bydrae tot die wêreld van musiek en kunste gelewer. Theart se teenwoordigheid kan in elke aspek van die fees waargeneem word. Hy betrek die deelnemers aktief by die vertonings. Hy het nie net gehelp om die karakter van die fees te ontwikkel nie, maar hy het ook 'n betekenisvolle bydrae gelewer tot die Suid-Afrikaanse kultuurlandskap deur sy besonderse leierskap en toewyding tot musiek en die kunste. Sy passie en verbintenis tot die KKNK inspireer mense steeds en illustreer hoe kuns positiewe verandering kan aandryf en 'n beter wêreld kan skep. Sy leierskap het die KKNK in staat gestel om 'n nuwe reis aan te pak en sy posisie as 'n Suid-Afrikaanse kulturbaken te bevestig.

Phillip Mthobeli Guma: ontvang die Minister se Spesiale Toekenning as erkenning vir sy verbintenis tot die behoud van gebruikstradisies en vir sy bydrae tot die Wes-Kaapse Inisisasieraamwerk en -protokol.

Dr. Phillip Mthobeli Guma is 'n merkwaardige individu wie se onwrikbare verbintenis tot die behoud van gebruikstradisies 'n onuitwisbare merk op die Suid-Afrikaanse samelewning gelaat het. As 'n akademikus en 'n praktiserende tradisionele geneser, beliggaam hy 'n unieke mengsel van akademiese strengheid en diep kultuuronderdompeling. Guma word gedryf deur sy passie vir die bevordering van biodiversiteit en kultuurpraktyke as integrale komponente van maatskaplike samehorigheid en nasiebou en hy het na vore getree as 'n baken van hoop vir die bewaring van die ryk tapisserie van Suid-Afrika se erfenis. Sy rol as 'n Mediese Antropoloog beklemtoon sy holistiese benadering tot die behoud van hierdie tradisies, wat die grense van beide die akademie en tradisie oorskry. Sy deurslaggewende bydrae tot die Wes-Kaapse Inisisasieraamwerk en -protokol is 'n bewys van sy verbintenis daartoe om te verseker dat hierdie eeuue oue gebruikte voortgaan om te floreer, wat 'n gevoel van identiteit en eenheid onder die mense van Suid-Afrika bevorder. Guma se onvermoeide pogings is 'n bron van inspirasie vir almal wat die belangrikheid daarvan ag om ons kultuurwortels te bewaar en te vier.

Crispin Sonn: ontvang die Minister se Spesiale Toekenning as erkenning vir sy uitstaande bydrae tot musiek en kuns.

Crispin Sonn dien as die voorstander van die Klein Karoo Nasionale Kunstefees (KKNK)-direksie. Onder sy leiding het die KKNK gegroei tot 'n gekoesterde familiefees wat besoekers nie net uit alle uithoekke van

Suid-Afrika nie, maar ook van regoor die wêreld trek. Sonn en die KKNK-span is daar toe verbind om deur die jaarlikse fees en verskeie ander projekte 'n positiewe en konstruktiewe bydrae tot nasiebou te lewer. Hulle doen dit deur 'n betroubare en oprechte deelnemer aan die kunstegemeenskap te wees, volhoubare platforms en innovering te bevorder, netwerke te koester en aktief by te dra tot ekonomiese en maatskaplike ontwikkeling. Sonn se leierskap en toewyding toon hoe die kuns 'n deurslaggewende rol kan speel om mense bymekaar te bring, begrip vir verskillende kulture te bevorder en 'n beter toekoms vir almal te bou.

Daniel Hugo: ontvang die Minister se Spesiale Toekenning as erkenning vir sy uitstaande bydrae tot Letterkunde (digkuns) en vertaling van verskeie boeke van Afrikaans na Engels en/of Nederlands of andersom.

Dr. Daniel Hugo is 'n gerekende digter, vertaler, samesteller en redakteur wat 'n onuitwisbare stempel op die wêreld van letterkunde afgedruk het. Sy veelsydige loopbaan is 'n bewys van sy onwrikbare verbintenis tot die geskrewe woord. Hugo het tydens sy loopbaan gedien as 'n spesialis-omroeper en vervaardiger vir Radio Sonder Grense, die nasionale Afrikaanse radiodiens. Hy het 'n deurslaggewende rol gespeel in die samestelling en aanbieding van literêre programme soos *Leeskring* en *Vers en Klank*. Hugo is 'n produktiewe digter en hy het verskeie digbundels gepubliseer. Sy gedigte vind aanklank by lesers en raak verskeie fasette van die lewe en menslike ervaring aan. Verder strek Hugo se bydrae tot die letterkunde verder as sy eie skeppings. Hy het erkenning verdien as 'n bekwame vertaler, wat die gaping tussen tale en kulture oorbrug. Sy vertalings van Nederlands na Afrikaans sluit werke van bekroonde skrywers soos Tom Lanoye, Herman de Coninck, Harry Mulisch, Herman van Veen, Karel Glastra van Loon en David van Reybrouck in. Hugo het deur sy vertalings die literêre landskap verryk en betekenisvolle Nederlandse letterkundige werke vir Afrikaanssprekende lesers toeganklik gemaak.

ATKV: ontvang die Minister se Spesiale Toekenning vir die bevordering van koorontwikkeling deur die Applous-program (40 jaar) en liedjieskryfprogram, Crescendo (50 jaar).

Die ATKV (Afrikaanse Taal- en Kultuurvereniging) en sy Applous-program is pilare van die Afrikaanse kultuur en erfenis in Suid-Afrika. Die ATKV, wat in 1930 gestig is, het ontwikkel tot 'n dinamiese organisasie met die missie om die Afrikaanse taal, kultuur en kreatiwiteit te bevorder en te bewaar. Die Applous-program, in die besonder, staan uit as die land se oudste skoolkoorkompetisie en bied 'n platform vir studente om hul liefde vir Afrikaans deur koormusiek uit te druk. Die geleentheid bring laer- en hoërskoolkore byeen en bevorder 'n gevoel van gemeenskap, trots en waardering vir Suid-Afrika se ryk taal- en kultuurtapisserie. Die ATKV speel deur hierdie inisiatiewe steeds 'n deurslaggewende rol in die verryking van die nasie se kultuurkarakter en die bevordering van die waardes van inklusiwiteit en diversiteit.

André van der Merwe: ontvang die Minister se Spesiale Toekenning ter erkenning dat die Stellenbosch Universiteitskoor die afgelope 11 jaar internasionaal as die beste gemengde koor ter wêreld vereer is.

André van der Merwe is 'n bekende koordirigent van Durbanville in Kaapstad. Hy het met sy besonderse leierskap en toewyding aan koorsang 'n onuitwisbare stempel op musiek gelaat. Die Stellenbosch Universiteitskoor en die Stellenberg Meisieskoor staan sedert 2003 onder Van der Merwe se leiding. Albei enssembles het 'n indrukwekkende reeks nasionale en internasionale toekennings onder sy kundige leiding verower. Hierdie prestasie lewer bewys van sy uitsonderlike vermoë om jong sangers te koester en te ontwikkel. Van der Merwe se vele prestasies sluit in sy verwerkings van Afrika-musiek wat deur Earthsongs in die VSA gepubliseer is, wat sy invloed op die globale koorrepertoriun verstewig het. Van der Merwe se bekwaamheid as dirigent is op die internasionale verhoog gevier toe hy in Julie 2018 die gesogte titel van Beste Dirigent by die Llangollen Internasionale Eisteddfod in Wallis verower het. Hierdie titel het sy status as 'n glanspersoon in die wêreld van koormusiek verder bevestig. Van der Merwe het gedurende sy loopbaan deur sy toewyding aan musiek grense oorskry en sy musiek talent het hom vanaf 2016 tot 2018 na musiekfeeste en kompetisies in lande so uiteenlopend soos China, Singapoer, Rusland, Wallis, Italië, Duitsland, Japan en Indonesië geneem. Van der Merwe se onvermoeide verbintenis tot die kuns van koordirigeer het nie net die lewens van talle sangers verryk nie, maar het ook Suid-Afrikaanse en internasionale koormusiek tot nuwe hoogtes verhef en 'n blywende nalatenskap in die harte en stemme nagelaat van almal wat die voorreg gehad het om saam met hom te werk.

Isabella Niehaus het 'n onuitwisbare stempel op die Suid-Afrikaanse kooktoneel afgedruk. Haar toekennings sluit onder ander in erkenning as een van die Top Vroue-restaurateurs en sy is 'n driemalige ontvanger van die gesogte Top 10 Vroue-sjefs in die Kaap-toekenning. Niehaus se kulinêre reis is niks minder as buitengewoon nie. Haar legendariese Sondagmiddagetes, voorgelê by haar skilderagtige huis wat oor die Langebaan-strandmeer uitkyk, het vreemdelinge in lewenslange vriende omskep en het in die proses die ware gees van gasvryheid beliggaam. Dit is egter haar literêre bydraes wat haar werklik van ander onderskei het. Haar kookboek, *Duinhus Smake, Geure*, het wêreldwyé aansien verkry deur die "Beste in die wêreld"-titel by die 2020 Gourmand World Cookbook-toekennings te verower en is 'n bewys van haar vaardigheid om die ryk geure van Suid-Afrikaanse kookkuns ten toon te stel.

Hazel Jonker: ontvang die Minister se Nalatenskap-toekenning as erkenning vir haar uitstaande bydrae tot erfenisbewaring en -bevordering in die Klein Karoo en spesiek Oudtshoorn.

Hazel Jonker is die gewaardeerde voorsteerder van Heritage Oudtshoorn Erfenis. Sy het 'n aktiewe rol gespeel in die bevordering van erfenisbewaring en -bevordering binne die Klein Karoo. Sy het in die besonder op die historiese dorpie Oudtshoorn gekonsentreer. Haar leierskap binne hierdie organisasie, wat nou saamwerk met De Rust Erfenis, was 'n dryfveer agter die uiters gedissiplineerde nakoming van die Wet op Nasionale Erfenishulpbronne in gebiede wat wemel van erfenishulpbronne van onskatbare waarde, veral De Rust. Jonker se openbare betrokkenheid as gasspreker by erfenisverwante geleenthede en haar aktiewe betrokkenheid by besprekings rondom erfenisinventarisering en oorleggesones in die Groter Oudtshoorn Munisipaliteit, wat De Rust, Dysselsdorp, Volmoed en Schoemanshoek insluit, onderstreep haar onwrikbare verbintenis tot die behoud van die kultuurnalatenskap van hierdie unieke streek. Jonker se bydraes getuig van haar passie om die ryk geskiedenis en kultuurerfenis van Oudtshoorn en sy omgewing te bewaar.

Fatima Dike: ontvang die Minister se Nalatenskap-toekenning as erkenning vir haar uitstaande bydrae in die veld van teaterkuns en drama.

Fatima Dike is 'n lig in die wêreld van teater en drama en word vereer vir haar merkwaardige bydraes tot die kunste. Dike is in Langa gebore en sy het haar reis na die wêreld van kreatiwiteit begin toe sy by haar swaer se boekwinkel in Langa gewerk het. Hier het haar vriendin Sue Clark haar aan die bewonderende digwêreld bekend gestel en dit het haar passie vir skryf aangevuur. In 1972 het die noodlot haar na die Nascent Space Theatre gelei, waar sy haar teaterloopbaan as assistent-verhoogbestuurder en uiteindelik as verhoogbestuurder begin het. Sy het toneelskryf as 'n uitdaging aangepak en haar eerste werk, *The Sacrifice of Kreli*, het haar die gesogte rol van professionele dramaturg by die Space Theatre besorg. Dike se artistieke reis het haar van Kaapstad na New York geneem en met haar terugkeer het sy haar onuitwisbare stempel afgedruk as verhoogbestuurder en aktrise in talle produksies, insluitend *Die Laaste Middagmaal*, *Fallen Angels* en *Lysistrata SA*. Sy het ook 'n reeks boeiende toneelstukke geskryf, insluitend *The First South African*, *The Crafty Tortoise* en *Street Walking*, wat haar uiteenlopende talente ten toon stel. Haar onuitwisbare impak op die teaterwêreld is verder geïllustreer toe sy die Siyasanga South African Theatre Company saam met Roy Sargeant in 2006 gestig het. Sy het tydens haar roemryke loopbaan mense geïnspireer en innovering aangemoedig. Sy is vereer met toekennings soos die Toekenning vir Lewenslange Prestasie ("Lifetime Achievement Award") by die Black Theatre Festival in Noord-Carolina in 2009 en die Naledi Lifetime Achievement-toekenning in 2014. Dike se blywende nalatenskap in teater en drama is 'n bewys van haar besonderse talent en onwrikbare verbintenis tot die kunste.

Tete Mbambisa: ontvang die Minister se Nalatenskap-toekenning as erkenning vir sy uitstaande bydrae tot musiek.

Tete Mbambisa is op 9 Januarie 1942 in Duncan Village, Oos-Londen gebore. Hy is een van die mees begaafde pianiste en komponiste wat in die 1950's grootgeword het. Mbambisa het die oorspronklike en unieke 1950's-klank lewendig gehou en baie van vandag se beste jong jazz-talente help ontwikkel. Hy het met sy vindingryke klavierspel gehelp om Suid-Afrika se akoestiese jazz-tradisie te bewaar tydens die genre se verval in die 1970's en 1980's. Mbambisa is 'n solis en hy het dikwels die sanger Ncediwe Sylvia Mdunyelwa begelei.

George Werner: ontvang die Minister se Nalatenskap-toekenning as erkenning vir sy uitstaande bydrae as jazzpianis.

George Werner is 'n merkwaardige pianis wat 'n onuitwisbare stempel op die Kaapse jazztoneel afgedruk het. Sy nalatenskap weergalm deur die Kaapse jazz-gemeenskap, in die besonder sy diepgaande toewyding

om jong talente in minderbevoorde gemeenskappe te koester. Hy het saam met mede-jazz-legende Ezra Ngcukana die Little Giants jazzgroep gestig en hom daartoe verbind om ontluikende musikante op te lei. Werner het meer as vier dekades gelede uit sy werk as 'n Telkom-tegnikus bedank en 'n musiekreis aangepak wat optredes tydens plaaslike feeste en op internasionale verhoë, insluitend Japan en Brasilië, insluit. Hy werk gereeld saam met jazz-helde soos Winston "Mankunku" Ngozi, Sylvia Mdunyelwa en Thandi Klaasen en sy musiek straal elegansie en harmonie uit. Sy verbintenis tot musiekopvoeding het hom in 2012 die SA Vereniging vir Jazz Onderwys (SAJE) toekenning vir vooraanstaande musiekonderwysers besorg. Onder sy mentorskap het talente soos Chris Engel, Sisonke Xonti en Shaun Johannes floreer. Vandag leef Werner se nalatenskap voort, nie in sy ongelooflike talent nie, maar in die vele lewens wat hy aangeraak het deur sy lewenslange verbintenis tot jazz en jeugopvoeding. Sy nederigheid nêrens beter sigbaar nie as in die feit dat hy steeds by plekke soos The Crypt in Kaapstad speel. Werner het 'n reuse bydrae op die gebied van musiek en mentorskap gelewer. Hy is 'n onbesonge held en die impak van sy werk eggo deur geslagte van musikante heen.

Alvin Dyers: ontvang die Minister se Nalatenskap-toekenning as erkenning vir sy uitstaande bydrae tot jazzmusiek as opvoeder en kitaarspeler.

Jazzkitaarspeler en opvoeder Alvin Dyers is in 1953 in Harfield Village (Kaapstad) gebore. Hy het op die ouerdom van sewe begin kitaar speel. Dyers het sy eerste groep, Sacred Legion, saam met sy ewe talentvolle broer, Errol Dyers, gestig. Hy was ook deel van die groep musikante wat in die 1980's in Pacific Express gespeel het. Van die musikante saam met wie hy al gespeel het, sluit ander legenedes in, byvoorbeeld Winston "Mankunku" Ngozi, Ezra Ngcukana en Johnny Fourie. Hy is tans 'n jazzkitaaronderwyser aan die Universiteit van Kaapstad, waar hy die volgende geslag jazzmusikante in die provinsie koester en inspireer.

Spencer Mbadu: ontvang die Minister se Nalatenskap-toekenning (postuum) as erkenning vir sy uitstaande bydrae tot jazzmusiek as baskitaarspeler.

Spencer Mbadu is in Januarie 1955 in 10de Laan, Mtshoko Block, Kensington gebore. Sy gesin is in 1958 met geweld na Nyanga-Wes (wat later Gugulethu genoem is) verskuif. Sy blootstelling aan musiek het by die huis plaasgevind, waar sy ouma vroeër die harp en klavier gespeel het. Vanaf vierjarige ouerdom het hy probeer om musiekinstrumente soos die kitaar, tromme en klavier te speel en hy het ook probeer sing. Hy kies in 1972 die bas as sy voorkeurinstrument. Mbadu het nooit formele musiekopleiding ontvang nie, maar hy noem wel dat Kader Khan hom aan bladlees bekend gestel het. Hy het aangesluit by orkeste soos Siyabuya, Skyf, Spirits Rejoice en Fever, waar hy musiek so uiteenlopend as grootorkes-musiek en popmusiek gespeel het. Hy het saam met verskeie

noemenswaardige musikante, onder andere, Abdullah Ibrahim, Bheki Mseleku, Sylvia Mdunyelwa, Ntemi Piliso, Tony Cedras, Russell Herman, Ezra Ngcukana en Enoch Mthalane, om maar 'n paar te noem, gespeel.

Zelda Benjamin: ontvang die Minister se Nalatenskap-toekenning as erkenning vir haar uitstaande bydraes as sanger ter bevordering van jazz en musiek.

Zelda Benjamin is 'n sanger en musikant gebore op 21 Oktober 1936 in Distrik Ses. Sy is 'n self-opgeleide jazzsanger en het op die ouderdom van 20 saam met die pianis Cecil May by die klub The Naaz in Laer Hoofweg, Woodstock begin sing. Sy verskyn sedertdien op die Kaapse musiek- en jazztoneel en neem deel aan danse en balsaalkompetisies. Benjamin het ook 'n opname saam met Basil Moses, Henry February, Monty Weber (tromme) en Charlie Hamilton gedoen. Tussen al die gesing deur moes sy ook ander werksgemeenskappe aangryp soos om by 'n droogsokonmaakmaatskappy en die Departement van Gesondheid te werk. Sy het egter nooit ophou sing nie. Benjamin tree vandag nog op en sy het haar verskynning gemaak by plekke soos Three Cellars, The Balalaika, Zambezi en vele meer.
