The initiatives only refer to agricultural related interventions which will be province specific and these include: Production: Food gardens and rainwater harvesting – inputs (seeds, fertilisers, Installation of vegetable tunnels, chemicals, manure, fencing, mechanisation where necessary) and water tanks Irrigation: Family drip irrigation, solar pumps and storage dams – other irrigation equipment including hose pipes, watering cans etc. Packaging: Fruit dryer renovations, (cold) storage for vegetables, pack house and packaging materials etc.
